COVID-19 SURVEILLANCE CASE DEFINITIONS

The Government of Uganda has declared the COVID-19 a national emergency. The National Task Force (NTF) activated the COVID-19 Incident Management System with an Incident Manager to coordinate the implementation of various preparedness activities. In order to enhance surveillance for COVID-19, the following case definitions have been developed to enable quick detection and prompt response.

Community case definition

Any person or groups of persons with flu-like symptoms such as fever, running nose, sneezing, cough, sore throat and difficulty in breathing

Suspect case

A. Any person with acute respiratory illness with high temperature (above 37.5°C) and at least one sign/symptom of respiratory illness (e.g., cough, shortness of breath), AND a history of travel to or residence in a location reporting community transmission of COVID-19 during the last 14 days prior to symptom onset;

OR

B. Any person with any acute respiratory illness AND having been in contact with a confirmed or probable COVID-19 case in the last 14 days prior to onset of symptoms;

OR

C. Any person with severe acute respiratory infection with high temperature (above 37.5°C) and at least one sign/symptom of respiratory illness (e.g., cough, shortness breath AND requiring hospitalization) AND in the absence of an alternative diagnosis that fully explains the clinical presentation.

Probable case:

A. A suspect case for whom testing for COVID-19 virus is inconclusive

OR

B. A suspect case for whom testing could not be performed for any reason

Confirmed case: A person with laboratory confirmation of COVID-19 infection, irrespective of clinical signs and symptoms
